Dear Dania Beach Customer:

The Public Utilities Department will begin its Annual Flushing Program on October 6, 2009 and it will end on November 14, 2009.

The Public Utilities Department will temporarily be changing its method of disinfection from chloramines back to free chlorination during the above period starting on October 2, 2009.

Please note: Owners and Managers of a Business with fish and shellfish holding tanks and users of Kidney Dialysis machines are advised that current methods for testing and removing chloramines will not be effective during the Flushing Program. You will have to test and adjust for free chlorine. The Hydrant Flushing may temporarily cause some cloudy discolored water, which should settle out in a few hours. This is just sediment in the line and is not harmful. The temporary switch sometimes leaves a chlorine taste or smell in tap water. You should know that the Broward County Department of Health mandates this Flushing Program.
